

Intra-Lebanese conflict

February-March, 1897

Described as a civil war with two factions, the Simon party and the [Adass/Facoory](#) party. On 8 February 1897 the elderly Mary Simon assaults [Antoni Adess's](#) teenage daughter Annie in Walker Street who had been in Facoory's house with several other Lebanese women after coming looking for Facoory who was asleep in another room. Charged with assault by Anthoni Adess, supported by evidence from Annie Facoory, Annie Adess and Antonie Nicholas.

Joseph Simon and Joseph Millen then charged with assaulting [Elias Facoory](#) in a follow up incident. They countercharged Facoory with the same charge.

About a week later, another ruckus in Walker Street between the [Facoorys](#) and the Farrys in the Assyrians quarters down a blind alley on the south side of Walker Street halfway between the Caledonia Hotel and the Rising Sun Hotel. Elsewhere described as occupying seven houses. This time [Elias Facoory](#) who had suffered a broken thumb in the previous incident got hit in the head with an iron file though he wasn't seriously injured. Everyone seems to have been involved but Michael George Ferry (Farry) was arrested for assault. But by the time the case reached the court the Lebanese had come to arrangements settle things amicably and the case was dropped.

Negative newspaper LTE followed about the Syrians in Walker Street and a petition to the DCC about insanitary housing area. But the DCC inspection that followed found that the Assyrian houses "about seven in number" were exceptionally clean and tidy.

In 1898 Michael Coory selling grocery business in Walker Street to move to Melbourne. The Education Board discuss the score of Assyrian children in Walker Street not attending school.

In November 1900 another violent fracas among Lebanese women in Walker Street. Mrs Nicholas vs Mrs Kate Antoni and her daughters Mrs Lettoff and Mary (or Mary Ann) Antonio. Started at Mrs Koori's house and spilled out into alleyway of Elson's Alley. Witnesses included child [Rose Howley](#) and Melhen Lettoof. Magistrate fund in favour of Mrs Nicholas and against the Antonis.

Followed by fighting between Lebanese men on Christmas Eve 1900 for which Joseph Hannah and Joseph George were charged as representatives and pleaded guilt. Legal reps guarantee there would be no repeat and given a small fine while charges against others dropped.

But there was more fighting in Walker Street in early January and Hanna Mansoor was cut on the head by Joseph Hanna, possibly using a tomahawk. Hanna arrested and released on substantial bail.

Another assault on Saturday 19 January involving Sam Joseph, John Lahood and Joseph Hanna. It was connected to the row on Christmas Eve. Hanna Mansoor, shopkeeper living in Meenan's Lane off Walker St, and the Lahoods (John and his wife) on Elson's Corner across the road. Mrs Lahood threatened to kill him, then attacked his wife. Then he was hit from behind by Joseph Hanna. Michael Howly and Sadie Litoff gave evidence too. So did Zarreefah George (wife of Michael) and [Annie Howley](#). And Tobias Isaacs, Halla Isaacs, Christina Issacs, John and Mary Lahood. [Joseph Hanna](#) ended up doing a month hard labour in Dunedin gaol as a result.

Was the split along sectarian lines? Not sure.

Fr Athanisius Kantapoulos was the first Greek orthodox priest sent to Melbourne in June 1898 and serving the new Greek Orthodox Church erected there in 1902. He soon fell out with his congregation,

however and in March 1904 was being sued for the return of the register of BDMs at the Church [Bendigo Advertiser 2 March 1904 p6.]. The congregation won the case.

George 28 and J 26 Howley, Assyrians arrived in Bluff per the *Monowai* from Hobart in July 1899.

Adess business at 32 Walker Street still in 1903

Inspection of Lebanese houses by MHR Arnold in 1907, Orthodox Adess still in Walker Street but most of the community Maronite. Reporter stated that most of the community came from Tripoli. Spokesmen Anthony Adess and Mr Coory. Some of them own their houses.

Also in 1907 Hanna Mansoor, Michael George and D Joseph buy the old Rising Sun Hotel.

In 1909 a civil dispute between Anthony Coory, Syrian merchant in Walker Street, with father and son hawkers Antonie and Jacob Idour after business dealings for years. Another case by Hannah Mansoor against them.

1911 Construction of Orthodox Church in Regent Street.

1914 fire in hawker George Boutary's big house at 74 Bayview Road.

1916 Farry and Coory get lease of the next section west from the Rising Sun Hotel.

1925 Tobia Isaac Coory's estate reveals ownership of shop and buildings at 835-839 King Street and freehold 4-bedroom brick cottage at 6 Arney Street, South Dunedin.
