

SAFE HANDLING OF MULTI-TRIP BULK BAGS

Please read below and follow these safety instructions:

- Visually inspect the bag for any visible damage particularly any rips, tears or major frays in the lifting straps. If these straps are damaged do not try to lift the bag.
- If you are using a forklift or tractor forks ensure the mast is tilted slightly back and the straps are securely placed in the v of the forks. If you are using a Hiab or Crane the straps must be locked evenly into a lifting hook.
- Check all lifting weights are within safe working loads and all persons are clear of loading areas.



- Untuck the spout cover flap on the bottom of the bag.
- Pull the spout nozzle clear.
- Untie the spout string to let the product flow. Always untie the bottom rope as cutting can lead to damage to the base & spout area of the bag.
- If the spout is left partially tied the flow rate of the product can be controlled. To increase loosen the rope on the bottom of the bag.



CAUTION: Never stand under a suspended bulk bag <u>ALWAYS</u> untie and operate from one side
