Ana Teofilo is a local full-time artist as well as a full-time mother to 3 young bliss children. *Palettes of Paradise Bliss* is a mixture of Teofilo's tropical green rings, colourful frangipanis, and round shaped swirl pieces. Over the past 7 years her paintings have been on squares and rectangles but over the last 2 years, Teofilo developed a love for working on circles and started venturing on to other shapes such as rings and frangipanis.

They have now become part of Teofilo's multi shape artworks and come in a different range of sizes. A common theme seen in her works is the connection of Pacific identity, storytelling journeys, carved tatau (tattoo) and siapo (tapa) designs.

The frangipani series is a favourite and an iconic motif design within the Pacific, derived from the Samoan siapo often mistaken for a flower but this symbol is called 'fa'atuli' which represents the footprints of the Sandpiper bird. This symbol represents femininity of their important duties within a Polynesian concept of balance, entwined with many siapo and tatau motifs. The round shapes represent life and the life cycle, it is about community, unity, and eternity. The movement in her swirls within 'Slice of Paradise' circles represent power and energy of personal journeys.

The uniqueness in Teofilo's practice involves carving each individual wooden painted board, and then encompassing the imagery with glues dot. The glue dots in her past works have been opaque which reflect the base and surrounding colours to enhance the threedimensional effects of the carvings but in this new collection of series the glue dots are painted over as the same colour as the background to add more depth with the carvings and add new shine to her works.

The strength of these new series are more than bright colours on wooden board with carved siapo and tatau designs that speak of the Pacific genre of art in New Zealand. Creating her own new traditions which are deeply rooted from her Samoan heritage and by a spiritual feeling that can only be felt in the moment of creating. "These are my stories that enable the assertion of my own identity" – Ana Teofilo
