
DCC And NZTA Roundabouts Work To Begin In March

We are pleased to announce that the NZTA and DCC have confirmed the time frame for the three roundabouts to be installed at the intersections on Main South Road/Brighton Road, Westland Street and the on/off ramp near Abbotsford (please see the below picture for approximate placement). The project will begin mid-March and will finish by 30 June 2018. Fulton Hogan were recently awarded the contract for all three roundabouts and will

work on the project as a whole. Some disruptions should be expected over this period but Fulton Hogan will try to do most of the work out of peak hours. The cost of the project comes in at just under two million dollars, with the NZTA paying two thirds of the cost and DCC paying one third. 




