6. HEALTH & SAFETY

Emergency Evacuation

- **Fire Wardens:** Bowey's Staff
- **Exit Routes:** Front (Crawford St) & back entrance (Vogel Street)
- **Designated Assembly Area:** Outside Mc Kenzie & Willis Store (corner) 97 Crawford Street.

Evacuation Procedure

If you hear the fire alarm or are warned of a fire:

1. Follow the instructions from the Bowey's Staff
2. Leave by the nearest fire **Exit Routes**. Move quickly, do **NOT** run.
3. Go to the **Designated Assembly Area**
4. Stay outside the building until the "all - clear" is given.

First Aid

- **Minor injuries:** Notify staff (First Aid Kit on site)
- **Major injuries:** Emergency services will be notified. Dial 111

Please be mindful, our staff can only provide basic first aid plasters, water and ice if necessary. They will assess the situation and act in the safest way possible for all concerned.
