

POLICIES OF THE DUNEDIN ROCK 'N' ROLL REVIVAL CLUB INC

- 1 A committee member or their nominee is to be the Club's representative member on the South Dunedin Community Hall Trust.
- 2 The Club does not accept non-members in positions such as dance instructors (exceptions – guest instructors).
- 3 All members who are not official helpers must pay to attend dance lessons (list of helpers to be available at door).
- 4 Out of town trips – the Club or its agent cannot be held responsible for factors outside its control. When booking motel type accommodation, it is recommended that written quotes are obtained.
- 5 Nationals – the Club will pay for entry fees for competitors and ticket price for the day of competition. The Club will buy one set of judging/scrutineering sheets. Top Team/Novelty events can apply for funding – to be treated case by case.
- 6 Funding for attending other New Zealand competitions – competitors' entry fees will be paid.
- 7 Quotes or, if appropriate, a budget must be brought to the committee for approval before any expenditure takes place on behalf of the club by any member. The club is not responsible for any expenditure by any member unless such expenditure is approved and minuted at a committee meeting.
- 8 Details of any Rock 'n' Roll lessons taken outside of the club by members are to be notified in writing to the committee prior to the event.
