CLUB COMPETITION RULES

1. The competitions are open to financial members of the Dunedin Rock'n'Roll Revival Club. Competitors must be financial members for the year in which the competitions are held and must have their membership approved by the committee 3 months prior to the competition. The competition will be held in June/July annually.

2. Junior Sections

Junior- 5 years to 10 years
Intermediate -11 years to 13 years
Seniors - 14 years to 17 years
Junior Restricted - 5 years to 12 years
Restricted - 5 years to 17 years
Novice - 5 years to 17 years
Junior Same Sex - 5 years to 12 years
Junior Same Sex - 5 years to 17 years
Triples Junior - 5 years to 13 years
Triples Intermediate - 5 years to 17 years

3. Senior Championship Sections

Open 18 years and over
Platinum 30 years and over
Golden 40 years and over
Masters 50 years and over
Diamond 60 years and over
Open Restricted 18 years and over
Senior Restricted 40 years and over
Diamond Restricted 60 years and over
Novice 18 years and over
Open Same Sex 18 years and over
Senior Same Sex 40 years and over
Open Triples 18 years and over
Senior Triples 40 years and over

Overall Club Champions Senior over 18 Overall Club Champions Juniors 5 – 17 years

- **4. Fun Sections** Not eligible for Overall Club Champions.
 - Unders and Overs, 1 junior & 1 Senior. Includes same sex
 - Participation in Unders and Overs does not constitute ineligibility in the Novice Section
 - Novelty All ages –

Dancing in a Higher Section – Junior Championship only. One partner of a couple in the Junior or Intermediate sections is entitled to dance up a section if, and only if, by adding two years to that person's age the competitor then fulfils the age requirements for the other partner's higher section. Likewise one or two members of a Junior Triples team can dance up a section if the third member is of Intermediate Triples age. Note that:

(i) The reverse cannot happen, i.e. a competitor cannot dance down a section.

- Each competitor may enter any section as appropriate to their age and is eligible for the Overall Club Championships as appropriate to their age.
- 6. The music will be selected from the National association Song List. Each heat/semi final/final will dance to one slow song and one fast song (as per National Association Guidelines.)
- 7. Any financial member of the club for at least 3 months may, in addition to the above, enter a Novelty event. The entry can consist of both senior and junior competitors. Novelty events shall be no longer than 5 minute duration.
- 8. The competition will be judged under the rules of The New Zealand Amateur Rock'n'roll Association rules for judging definitions as contained in their rule book.

- 9. Returnable trophies are awarded to the winners in each category. The trophies are to be returned in a clean condition no later than two weeks prior to the following years competition.
- 10. The competition will be judged by a number of judges as decided by the committee.
- 11. Judges and scrutineer's sheets will be available within one week of the competition.
- 12. If on the day if there is only one entry in a category, they will be awarded the trophy and may have to dance on the floor with another section as decided by the committee/floor manager.

13. **DEFINITIONS**

- A couple is defined as one male and one female dancer, or in the same sex category two dancers of the same sex.
- Competitor means a person, being an accepted entrant for the competition.
- An entry is defined as one couple or team as appropriate to the section they have entered.
- A Triples team is defined as three dancers.
- A Novice couple means neither partner have danced in any rock'n'roll competition previously.
