### Fire Brigade Concerned at Lack of Transparency

The Milton Volunteer Fire Brigade has expressed its deep disappointment with the Clutha District Council's lack of communication regarding not only the expansion of the camping ground at Taylor Park, but also roading changes of Eden St with no consultation. The brigade's concerns centre around the lack of transparency and consultation in the decision-making process, which has left them feeling frustrated.

For over a century, Taylor Park has served as a training and competition ground for waterways competitions, a tradition that the brigade takes great pride in. Recent changes have left the fire brigade with unusable competition grounds and unanswered questions about the reclassification of the park from a sports ground to a camping ground.

The brigade's grievances primarily revolve around the lack of transparency throughout the process. They assert that the change of use at Taylor Park was initiated without adequate communication or consideration of its impacts on existing users and the wider community. Also changing Eden St to heavy traffic access to the fuel stop will have a have an effect on the fire service, St Johns and our Medical Centre, all with no consultation with any of these services. Despite their earnest efforts to engage with local councillors, their concerns have seemingly fallen on deaf ears.

They hope that this will serve as a catalyst for increased transparency, better communication, and enhanced community involvement in all future decisions regarding community spaces.
