Last week was another awesome week at Tokomairiro High School. It was great to see our students being highlighted in both the Clutha Leader and the ODT. A number of our Year 9 and 10 students helped the Milton Lions Club with their annual collection for Blind Low Vision NZ. We held both our annual Swimming Sports and also our first ever Tokomairiro Lawn Bowls Championship. Competition at both events was strong and all of our competitors made us proud. I would also like to acknowledge the help and support that we were given from the members of the Milton Bowls Club in volunteering their time and facility and also the staff at Milton Pool, without the support of our community we would not have been able to provide our students with these events.

Please also remember that the next week is also a short week at school. School will be closed on Friday, Monday and Tuesday for Easter.

Athletics Success

Following on from the success that our student had at the South Otago Primary Schools Sports association Athletics Championships. Dominic Dobson attended the Southland Primary Schools Athletics Championships last weekend in Invercargill. Dominic performed extremely well, he placed 2nd in both the 100m and 200m and went one step further and won the Long Jump. We are super proud of his achievement and look forward to seeing how he performs in future events.

We have a team of older students going to the South Island Athletic Championships in Timaru on the first weekend of April.

Cellphones at School

I have also emailed out to caregivers a copy of the new cellphone policy that will come into effect at the start of next term. If you did not receive a copy of this or you do not have an email address a paper copy is available at the school office. Additionally cellphone exemption request forms will be available at the office.

NCEA Subject Endorsements

Last week I spoke about overall NCEA certificate endorsements and how students can attain these endorsements. In addition to certificate endorsements students can have a particular course or subject endorsed. Subject or course endorsements are available at all levels of NCEA and can be awarded in conjunction to a certificate endorsement or independently. They show a student has a high level of attainment in a particular course or courses.

To be eligible for a course endorsement a student must attain at least 14 credits in a single course in a single academic year. With the exception of Physical Education and Level 3 Visual Arts at least three credits must be from an internally assessed standard and at least three credits from an externally assessed standard.

So for example if a student obtained 17 credits at merit in Level 3 Physics 10 of which are from the external exams at the end of the year and the remaining seven from internal standards. The student would attain a Merit Endorsement for Level 3 Physics. If however, the student had attained 14 of the credits at an Excellence standard and the other three at Merit then the student would attain Level 3 Physics endorsed with Excellence.

PTA

Last week the PTA held their AGM. At the meeting Tracy Coulter stepped down as President of the PTA and Tania Jacobs stepped down as Secretary. Both Tracy and Tania have devoted many hours of their time to the PTA over recent years and their knowledge and enthusiasm have been invaluable. We thank them both very much for their contribution to our school community.

We are very fortunate to have such an active PTA who help create and fund opportunities for our students that would not normally be available to a school of our size. I am looking forward to welcoming some new members at our next meeting and if you would like to become involved please do not hesitate to contact the school to find out some more information. The next PTA meeting will be Wednesday 1st May at 7pm in the staffroom at school.

Forestry Pathways Course Report Feb /March 2024

The Forestry Pathways Course started on the 23rd February with eight students. Two are from Trinity College, two from Kings High School, three Otago Boys and one from South Otago High School.

Over the last three weeks we have completed inductions followed by Health & Safety Units Standards: 17769 (Demonstrate General Health, Safety, and Environmental Requirements in Forestry), and 22994 (Demonstrate Knowledge of Factors that affect the Performance of Forestry Workers.)

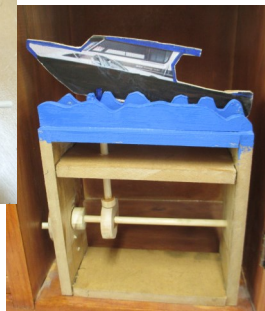
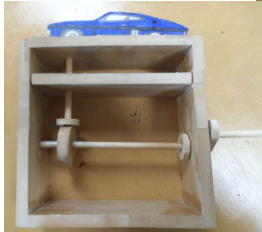
On the first week of March, we visited Berwick, Mount Allan, and Otago Coast Forests.

Visits this month have included:

- Gorton's Sawmill
 - Johnson's Forestry Services waste thinning crew along with Johnson's Forestry Services 1st lift pruning crew.
 - Purakanui Falls to look at podocarp and beach forest types.
 - Dunedin Botanical Gardens as part of tree knowledge for native and exotic species.
 - Drug testing of all students as a pre - employment requirement for all types of work within the forestry industry.
- We have also completed unit standard 17772 (Demonstrate Environmental Requirements of Forestry Operations)
 - Alistair McKenzie, Forestry Tutor

Beyond the Classroom

This term has seen our Milton Primary School akonga gaining many opportunities to learn outside classrooms. Every year our Year 5&6 students count down the days until Adventure Week, a week full of challenges designed to build their leadership through outdoor education. This year, Adventure Week involved cycling the the ILT velodrome, Splash Palace, two nights at Camp Columba with adventure activities and team games, a farm day with team building activities and a day tramp up McNally's track.

Next, our whole school were lucky enough to attend education programmes at Sinclair Wetlands - Te Nohoaka o Tukiauau to begin our learning on local waterways. With four visits across the week, including an enrichment group visit, our learners have walked the tracks, listened to purakau (narratives), spotted wildlife, learned about the wetlands plants, taken part in raranga (weaving) and learned about the history and science behind this place of local significance.

We are concluding our term with a trip to Toko Mouth, furthering our understanding of our local waterways, their features, health and stories.

We are grateful to our parents who volunteer their time to support us and our Board of Trustees who cover the cost of trips such as these so that all children can access these rich experiences at no cost to families.

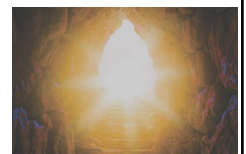

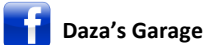
