Lots to Try at Science Roadshow

The Science Roadshow was held at Tokomairiro High School on Tuesday the 7th November. This is a fun, exciting and interactive learning experience of science for all school age students.



The National Science-Technology Roadshow trust has been delivering programmes like the Science Roadshow for 35 years. These programmes included live shows and hands-on exhibits that broaden students' knowledge of science, technology, engineering and mathematics.

The live shows, this year, talked about "Mighty Materials" such as metals and fabrics and how these are put to use in everyday applications and "Sounding Out Waves" which investigated pitch, volume, how fast sound travels and the many effects these have on things we can or cannot hear.

Along with Tokomairiro's Year 7-10 students, we were fortunate enough to host students from St Mary's Milton, Clutha Valley School, Lawrence Area School and also had a special visit from Mayor Bryan Cadogan. The Science Department would like to take this opportunity to thank the PTA for funding this event for our students.

End of Term Activities

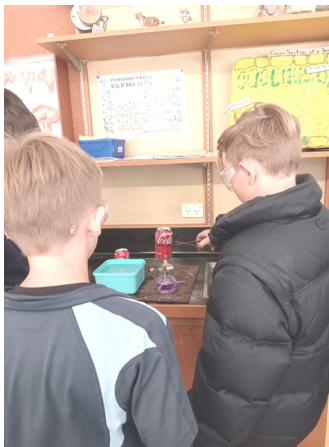

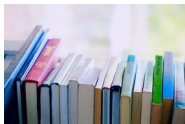
Storylines Tour Visit

On Thursday afternoon, 16 November, year 7-8 students and a select few from 9-10 were treated to a free visit from the non-profit Storylines Organisation.

Students gathered in the library after lunch and were firstly introduced to a very useful talk by Sonya Wilson, who has recently had the book, "Spark Hunter" published. This book is set in Fiordland, which she is familiar with, having grown up in Invercargill. She very skilfully showed us how we could use our own experiences to stretch our imaginations. By moving between slides of photos and a map she showed us how she created the world of the mythical creatures in "Spark Hunter". She engaged the students by asking them more than once, "What if...?" Going by student response to, "What if you came to school and there were no teachers there?", we could see that imagination could be set alight with just the ordinary! Sonya also talked about the importance of research to make your story seem realistic. To do this she revealed the in-depth research she had done around some of our native birds.

The second part of the presentation came from the comic book artist, Michel Mulipola, who grew up in Mangere, Auckland. Although he did not give us any tips on drawing, Michel revealed through his presentation, the many opportunities he has made use of. He has achieved success as a professional wrestler and gamer as well as artist. Students and staff were taken on a colourful trip through his life.

A special thank you is due to the librarian, Greig Daniels, for organising this visit on behalf of teachers and students.



Overdue Library Books

Tokomairiro High School Summer Reading Programme



As the school year comes to an end it is time to start gearing up for the 2023 –2024 Summer Reading Programme. Students collect their book selection in the last week of Term 4. All books are due back at the beginning of Term 1, 2024.

Reading for pleasure and information is one of the strongest skills students can have. Access to books over the summer helps to keep up students reading mileage. Reading mileage means the more a child reads the easier it becomes for them. Continued recreational reading adds to students' vocabulary, their comprehension. It also helps students to express themselves confidently both orally and on paper.

As the new NCEA literacy standards come into effect the stakes are higher and students need to be confident readers who can express themselves clearly and effectively. Recent studies have shown that reading on devices such as phones and tablets provides a reading experience that is much more superficial. Students' ability to focus and concentrate is better served by reading on paper and engaging with longer texts both fiction and nonfiction.

Being part of the Summer Reading Programme means that students have texts at hand to read for enjoyment and to add to their reading skills. As parents and caregivers, it would be a good way to encourage students learning and to prepare them for the 2024 school year.

Students can sign up at the library. They can also ask Mr Daniels to help them choose items that they may enjoy. There will also be 3 major prizes randomly hidden in the reading bags and some treats included for each student.

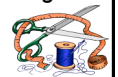
