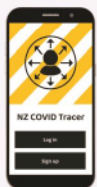

## Week Two, Term One

### Tena koutou katoa,

I hope you all had a wonderful long weekend as we, as a nation, celebrated Te Tiriti o Waitangi, New Zealand's founding document. The sun certainly shone on us all.

We have completed our first week of the year and it was great to see the students back and engaged in learning. We have been thrilled about how well our new Year 7 students have settled into life here at Tokomairiro High School.

**Connections with Whanau** - We are looking forward to a great year and encourage members of our wider school community to take every opportunity to engage with our school. Our doors are always open and we welcome you into our school. Our first Parent-Student-Teacher meetings are planned for Wednesday 17 February, with our Family Learning Conferences.

**Family Learning Conferences** - Wednesday 17 February - these are designed as three-way conferences between the student, whanau and the house group teacher. This is an opportunity to discuss student goals for the year and put plans in place. These are scheduled for 15 minutes each. Bookings can be made on Skool Loop - the interview bookings are now open and parents are encouraged to make an appointment with their child's House Group teacher. It is very easy to do on the Skool Loop app or, ring the school office if you need some assistance. 15-minute appointments can be made any time from 1.30pm through until 6.45pm.

**Skool Loop App** - be sure to download the Skool Loop App from Google Play or App Store. Through the Skool Loop app you can send notification of absences, read school notices, receive notifications, sign permission slips and book interviews.

**Parent Teacher Association** - we are desperately in need of more parents joining our PTA. The PTA are a very important part of our school and provide subsidy for numerous school activities for students of all levels. Being part of the PTA does not take a huge time commitment. Meetings are usually held

twice per term and usually only last an hour to an hour and a half. The vast majority of our funds are raised through the trail ride. Please consider making yourself available to be part of the PTA - the more members we have the easier it is all round. The first meeting of the year is scheduled for Wednesday 17 February at 7.00pm in the school staff room. All parents/whanau welcome.

**Summer Reading Programme/Overdue Books** - It was great to see students pick up their holiday reading at the end of 2020. These bags and books are due back at the library now that 2021 has started. There are also still many books overdue from previous years. Parents and caregivers please encourage students to return these as soon as possible. Books can be dropped off at the Tokomairiro High School Office or the School Library.

**Attendance / Lateness** - We are continuing to have a focus on attendance this year as we believe regular attendance and achievement go hand in hand. Research has shown that attendance to class is a key to students reaching their academic potential. It is important that all students are attending school every day. We ask that parents / caregivers /whanau ensure that their children are attending all their lessons. If there is a valid reason for a student to be absent from school, parents are asked to contact the school office, or send a message through the Skool Loop App, first thing in the morning. Thank you for your support in helping us better monitor the student attendance. This year we will be following up on lateness to class. We encourage all students to be in class before the second bell ready to start work. This means students need to be in class by **8.40am**.

We are looking forward to a great year and welcome all our new parents to our Tokomairiro family. Remember, our doors are always open. Please come and talk to us if you have any concerns.

Our focus this year is on Community - building a strong community within our school and strengthening our connections to our wider community.

## HPV Vaccination Programme

The Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccination programme will be offered to all Year 8 students at school this year. During early-mid February, the Public Health Nurses associated with each school will be doing education around the vaccinations to the Year 8 students. The students will be given a consent form to take home to their parents/caregivers. If you do not wish for your child to partake in the education please contact the school.

Please read the consent form carefully, fill it out in pen and return it to school ASAP, even if you do not consent for your child to be vaccinated at school. No student will be vaccinated without their parent/caregiver's consent.

The HPV vaccination is also available free of charge through your practice nurse or doctor up to their 26th birthday. Delaying the vaccine may mean your child needs more injections to be protected, as people aged 15 years and older need three injections.
