Students Using New Laser Cutter




Early last week the new laser cutter for Tokomairiro High School arrived from China.

Mr Stevens has it set up in the Hard Materials classroom and is busy becoming familiar in using it. He has been experimenting with it, and there have been some great samples turning up on the staff room table each day. Cuttings are created using a silhouette, and the finished product can be made of wood or plastic.

A number of the students are showing a real interest in getting to know how to use it and it won't be long before you see them bringing home some of the products they have designed and made.

Careful monitoring of student progress throughout the year means individual support is put in place when needed. 100% of our year 12 students last year gained NCEA Level 2 - an outstanding result.



Obituary - Bronwyn Robins

Bronwyn Robins was born in Milton on 13th September 1967. She lived in her family home most of her life at 1 Highgate, and passed away peacefully there with family and close friends by her side on 21 April 2020.

Bronwyn started her working career in banking and lived in Australia for some time before training as a nurse then as a midwife in Invercargill. She worked as a midwife there before moving back to her home in Milton and



became a paediatric nurse at Dunedin Public Hospital.

Sixteen years ago she started working part time at the Milton Medical Centre as a Practice Nurse, eventually becoming the Clinical Team Leader.

Bronwyn was a product of her solid upbringing and was passionate about her community. She gave back ten-fold. Through her involvement in many organisations and committees such as Milton Area Promotions, St John Ambulance, Tokomairiro High School Netball and most recently the Milton Community Pool project.

Bronwyn bought a crib at Crystall's Beach and this was Initially a sanctuary for her and her mother Ruth. Bronwyn and her wee dog Millie loved getting over the hill on a regular basis too. As she had a strong interest in the area, she wanted to record the history of the beach and had started working on this before she passed away.

Bronwyn collected many people along her journey, lots of groups of friends and colleagues. She had passions that she not only participated in for self-fulfillment, she threw herself in and it became a project, paid or unpaid.

Bronwyn's community, colleagues and friends were her family and she will be missed by all.


