The Southern Stop Smoking Service provides a free southern-wide service offering community group clinics and one-on-one support with eight site coaches operating across the Southern region. They provide free nicotine replacement therapy resources (including, gum, lozenges and patches) and coaching to support you on your journey to become smoke-free.

Donna will be holding weekly clinics at the Tokomairiro Community Hub every Wednesday between 10am and 12pm. The clinic is open and free to everyone and free nicotine replacement therapy is also supplied. If you are feeling like the time has come to make a change, pop in to see Donna on a Wednesday!

Science Fair 2023

Tokomairiro High Science Fair for 2023 was again another outstanding event in the school's calendar. With the change in format of having a Yr9 and 10 Investigative Science class, instead of all year group student participation, we still managed to have 48 entries submitted.

From there 10 students were selected and taken to the Otago Aurora Science and Technology Fair in August. This section is the individual judging section and though daunting our students came away feeling like they had represented themselves well.

With nearly 300 entries coming in from the Otago area, Tokomairiro High School students were again successful.

Tokomairiro 2023 Aurora prize winners are Ivy Clarke, Year7, winning an Aurora Energy Award and an Otago Medical Research Foundation Award for her project titled "Do athletic students have better lung capacity than non athletic students", Sam Clark and Sophie Greer" winning a Sustainable Agriculture, Ballance Agri-nutrients Award for their project titled "What is the best water environment for invertebrates and aquatic life" and Sophie Clarke, Pippa Green, Saffron Healey and Joelle DeSeymour all receiving Highly Commented.

The Science Department would like to take this opportunity to congratulate, not only those that participated at Aurora, but to all our student body who participated in this year's Science Fair.
