South Otago Fire Brigade **Competitions**

Milton hosted the South Otago Fire Brigade Competitions at Taylor Park on Saturday. The Milton brigade entered two 4-man and four 2-man teams, completing a range of events which simulated fire fighting using different hosing techniques. The Milton runs were shared between Michael Eaton, Liam Gibson and James Agnew.

In the Four Man teams event, Mataura won with 177 points, and Balclutha came 2nd with 174 points. In the Two-Man event, Mossburn came first with 180 points and Milton came in fourth with 132 points. Milton gained three third placings, and came fourth overall.

Competitions continued on Sunday in Kaitangata with the Watt Cup.

Champs in Balclutha in a fortnight's time.
