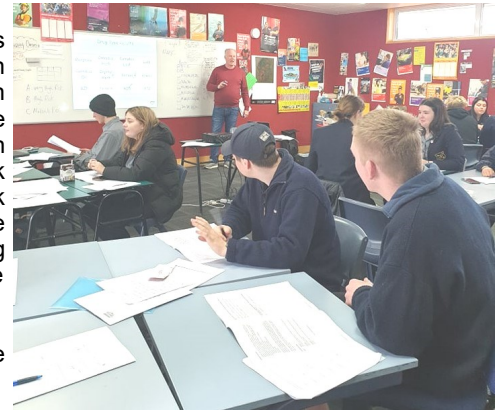

There were two parts to it; the first on identifying the causes of back injury and methods to prevent back injuries in the workplace, and the second on management of drug and alcohol related problems in the workplace.

Students who successfully completed the course will achieve NCEA Level Three credits.

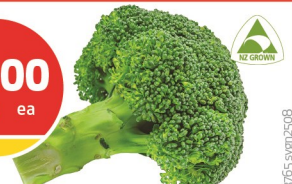

Rob and Zareen have been touring NZ, speaking in schools to parents and caregivers about what they have learned, and continue to learn on their journey, not only in relation to porn and predator exposure, but

also with regard to certain social media, cyberbullying and the effect of being switched on 24/7 on the developing brain. Younger and younger students are now accessing the online world. At this evening you will be given practical solutions to keep your children safer online and learn what to do if your child has been exposed to something harmful. 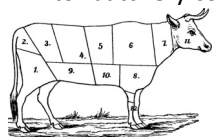

Clutha District Council Essential Services

During this COVID-19 Level 4 shutdown Clutha District Council will be maintaining essential services.

Clutha District Mayor Bryan Cadogan said it was important that everyone followed the strict Level 4 protocols set out by central government for keeping themselves and their families safe.

He urged anyone in the district with concerns to contact Council on 0800 801 350.

Here is a list of Council's essential services:

CONTACT Phone our usual number: 0800 801 350. This will be staffed 24/7 during this time.

Online: follow the blue 'Report a Problem' button on the front page of our website.

CLOSED Balclutha Library, Owaka Library, Milton Library, Tapanui Library, Balclutha Centennial Pool, Balclutha i-Site Council Service Centres: Owaka, Tapanui, Lawrence, Milton, Rosebank Office.

Landfill and transfer stations closed to public. Only receiving from essential services.

ANIMAL CONTROL We will be maintaining a skeleton service to look after animal welfare and aggression issues. Please contact us via the methods at the top of this message.

CIVIL DEFENCE Civil Defence will continue to operate throughout this period. Support is being given to local health providers, and you.

COMMUNICATIONS Council website and facebook pages will continue to be updated. However, please DO NOT report problems via Facebook. We will not be able to generate a service request for you. Please report problems via: Phone our usual number: 0800 801 350. This will be staffed 24/7 during this time.

Online: follow the blue 'Report a Problem' button on the front page of our website.

Antenno: Download Antenno, the free mobile app that sends you notifications and alerts about the Clutha District Council news and you can also use it to report a problem.

GREENSPACE This is not considered an essential service and as such mowing and gardening operations will cease.

PLAYGROUNDS All Council playgrounds are now closed to the general public. We recognise that we cannot physically close all the locations, but people are reminded that these high-risk areas are not included in the Government's guidance as acceptable outdoor exercise areas during the lockdown.

PUBLIC TOILETS Our public toilets will remain OPEN so that they are available for workers travelling on essential business. However our cleaning regimes will change and while we will maintain them to the highest cleanest standard we can, we remind people that they are high-risk areas and should only be used if absolutely necessary.

RATES Rates processing will continue as normal during this time. However, we ask you to pay via online or you can choose to pay by Direct Debit – just type 'paying online' in the search function on Council's website. If you have any queries regarding this, please phone 0800 801 350.

ROADING Work will continue to be done on our roads so that essential services can continue to use the network. Customer Service Requests that involve safety issues will be dealt with on a priority basis.

RUBBISH Kerbside collection will continue during the Level 4 lockdown. Please put your bins out as normal.

Remember, all transfer stations and Mt Cooe landfill are closed to the public.

SERVICE REQUESTS/REPORT A PROBLEM If you have a problem to report, please continue to phone our usual number: 0800 801 350. This will be staffed 24/7 during this time.

Online: follow the blue 'Report a Problem' button on the front page of our website.

Antenno: Download Antenno, the free mobile app that sends you notifications and alerts about the Clutha District Council news and you can also use it to report a problem.

WATER Essential work on water and wastewater services will continue but Public Health is our priority.

We will continue to respond to problems with our systems, however, reports of minor issues may not be resolved during this time.

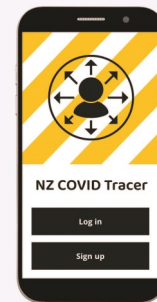

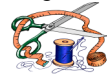

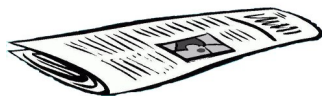
