This session was facilitated through the South Otago Future Focus Learning Project by digital technologies guru Phillipa Dick. These students successfully created a 3D model using *Tinkercad* and animated it using the programme *Mixamo* on their Chromebooks.

It was great to see the short time frame did not dampen the creativity of

these students.

We look forward to hearing how they all go teaching their peers about this software in their upcoming Digital Technologies classes.

This year's World Vision 40 Hour Famine was introduced to students during last week's student led assembly. For over 45 years, young people of Aotearoa have stood together and shown the world what our small nation is capable of through the World Vision 40 Hour Famine. Right now, the fall-out from the COVID-19 pandemic is pushing millions of kids in sub-Saharan Africa to the brink of starvation, and many may not survive. Our students are planning to run the 40 Hour Famine with the goal of raising \$1000. This will provide four community gardens for families in sub-Saharan Africa. They are also planning some smaller activities during the week of 28th June at school.

Our speaker was Olivia Mathieson who talked on the background to the "Blessed Box" service. When her baby arrived in 2020, both Olivia and husband Dylan appreciated receiving meals and baking, and felt other parents would also appreciate this. By January 2021 a group of interested family and friends had formed a group who meet at the Toko High school on a monthly basis. About 200 babies are born in South Otago yearly and about 20 boxes are filled each month. Local midwives inform the group of recent births. Each box contains a main meal, healthy snacks and beauty and hygiene products, much of which is donated to the group. The area covers Waihola, Tapanui to the Catlins. The great-grandmothers and grandmothers in our group reflected on their own experiences after having their babies. All members wished Olivia well with this enterprise.
