Personalised Timetables for Year 9 and 10 Students

We are very excited about where the review of our Year 9 and 10 curriculum is taking us and there are some big changes happening in 2022 and beyond.

Next year students will have the opportunity to study more of what they love and therefore accelerate their learning in their areas of passion. They will still be required to choose courses from a broad range of curriculum areas so will still be maintaining a full curriculum but within each curriculum area there will be choice. The courses are designed to cater to students strengths and interests and allow them to see more relevance in their learning.

Some examples of courses being offered are:

English - Social Media & Fake News, Into the Unknown, Gaming, Rhythm & Blues, Te Papa/ Turangawaewae, Choices and Challenges;

Physical Education - Camping and Tramping, Around the World Games, Train to Gain, Commitment to Community, Leisure, My Team and I;

Science - Amazing Bodies, Communication in Science, EnviroScience, Growing Great, Hunting and Fishing, Lotions and Potions, Medicine and Warfare, Sports Science;

Food Technology - Gate to Plate, Magic Carpet rRde, What's Eating You?;

Social Studies - Gods and Heroes, Like A Boss, Mythbusters, Early Beginnings;

Digital Technology - Become a technology ninja, Discover the film magic, Design the robotic world, Create the new reality in 3D;

Drama - Mask, Movement and Melodrama, Playback Theatre and Scripted Comedy;

Dance - Boogie Wonderland;

Music - In the Studio, Passion Project;

Visual Art - Graffiti Art: Send a message, Cultural Wellbeing.

We will be holding an information evening next Wednesday 27th October in the School Hall for parents of our current Year 8 and 9 students to find out more about the curriculum and answer questions.

Here is a list of the initial thoughts of what Deacon would like to take in Year 10:

Graffiti Art, Lotions and Potions (Science), Hunting and Fishing (Science), Like a Boss (Economics and Business studies), Early Beginnings (Social Studies), Movement and Melodrama, Play (Drama), Your Games, Your Rules (Digitech), From Gate to Plate (Food Tech), 2 ∞ & Beyond (Maths), Made 2 Measure (Maths), Into the unknown (English), Te Papa / Turangawaewae (English).

Deacon will also select Kapa Haka as one of his courses. This sure sounds like an exciting curriculum. His biggest problem will be cutting back to twelve courses for the year!

Term 4 will allow some of our Youth Guarantee (16 and 17 year olds) to complete NCEA Level 2.

Many of our trainees find our self-paced, unit standard based and small class sized environment, a very suitable model for their style of learning.

Unit standards offered include pre employment and core generic skills. A good selection of Health & Safety standards are also on offer and encouraged. These standards are popular with trainees as they see the usefulness of not only gaining Level 2 credits from them, but also the necessary skills and knowledge needed for many forms of employment.

Year 9/10 Curriculum for 2022

The option booklet will be out to students this week. No sound from Tom – I unbuckle my seatbelt and try to free myself, but I'm trapped in my seat. My voice gets stronger and I feel I am yelling at Tom, willing him to answer and reassure me he is okay.

How could this have happened? Fearless no more – I am scared for my life, but also for my friends.

As I painfully reach down to find my phone reality begins to sink in,
