

Holiday Vandalism Caught on Camera

We were disappointed to see that areas of town were vandalised over the holiday and our school was not exempt. Monday 25th September at about 8.30pm two youths tipped over and proceeded to smash up the picnic table outside the gym.

Tuesday 26th September at about 8.30pm, three youths set fire to a large rubbish bin on the tennis courts. The local fire brigade attended to put the fire out.

Friday 6th October at about 1.30am a youth entered the school property from the main road and proceeded to break four windows in the administration building.. The same.youth then continued down the main road to the 4 Square and broke a window there.

All incidents were captured on the school CCTV and referred to the police. The police were able to identify all the youths involved and are dealing with them on an individual basis. These incidents have cost the school a large amount of time and money to repair the damage and take away funds from other projects and activities.
