Happy New Year, I hope you have all enjoyed some time with whānau. I certainly have enjoyed some well overdue quality time with my family in the UK but I am looking forward to seeing some summer weather next week when I arrive back in Milton. I am also looking forward to the new school year and meeting our new students and staff. I am feeling very optimistic about this year and am looking forward to working with the School Board and staff on the new strategic plan and building on our successes.

Start of Year

This year we will be starting school on Monday 29th January. This day will be for Year 7 and Year 13 students only. The day will start with a mihi whakatau to welcome our new students into our school. 
