Cultural Competition 2023

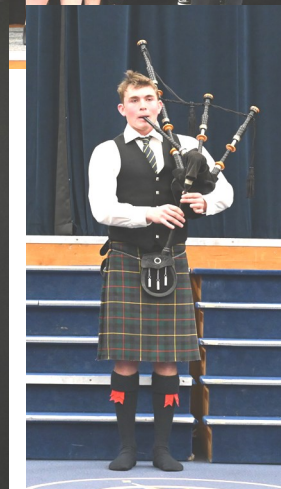

Milton Rotary Change Over

Milton Rotary changeover evening took place on July 31st. Retiring President Ross Pringle reviewed activities and grants that the club had been involved with over the year. Ross specifically noted the record dividend from the Tramping Club had allowed many community groups and projects to be funded. These included Tokomairiro sports teams, students attending Outward Bound, Milton Community Project Board and local families in hardship. The club has made a substantial commitment to The Milton Community Facilities Trust for the new swimming pool.

A personal highlight for Ross was his involvement with local builder Marty Clark in fabricating a pre-school building on the island of Malakula in Vanuatu. This was a project initiated by Dunedin North Rotary but using the skills of Milton Rotary's Ross Pringle and Marty Clark. Ross thanked Milton Rotary for paying their air fares. Working bees have been at Tatuku Camp, erecting a tunnel house at the Milton community gardens and maintenance on a section of the Clutha Gold Cycle Trail. As usual many members have been involved in leading tramping and cycling trips over the season.

Two Paul Harris Fellows were recognized at our changeover. Well known local Brian Griffin was awarded a Paul Harris Fellow for his twenty year commitment in organizing the Lake to Sea trail ride. This has been a great fundraiser for Tokomairiro High School. The second recipient was Glenis Sim. Glenis was Principal of Tokomairiro High School from 2014-2021, a member of Milton Rotary and club President in 2017/18. Glenis played a significant leadership role within our community and Rotary. Ross also noted the resignation of long serving member Rob Wilton. Rob has played a very active role in Milton Rotary and the wider Rotary district as well as the Tramping Club and many other community organizations.

Another feature of the evening was the induction of four new members; Robbie Philip, Ross Flett, Marty Clark and Stan Leishman.

President Ross's final role was to pass on the President's job for the coming year to Robin Taylor.
