We are now into the final week of what has been a very busy and successful term. When I reflect over the past term I find it unbelievable how much we have accomplished as a school community in all aspects of school life. In a lot of ways it doesn't feel like five minutes since we welcomed our new ākonga and kaiako into our kura, but in other ways it feels like they have always been part of our Tokomairiro whānau. In assembly this week we acknowledged one of our Year 13 students, Jeremy Coleman, who joined us at the start of the year, by making him a prefect. During the past term Jeremy has exhibited all the attributes we expect from a prefect and I am confident that he will add further strength to our already great prefect team. I hope staff and students alike enjoy their well earned break from school and I look forward with anticipation to see what next term delivers.

Athletics Success We have had a great athletics season and the final athletics meet of the term proved to also be successful. Last weekend 10 students attended the South Island Championships in Timaru. Alec Murray secured 4th place in shot put, Jeremy Coleman and both of our relay teams all secured PBs in their event. The competition was extremely high and we are very proud of the performance of our athletes. Also a huge thank you to Mrs Winder who coached and accompanied the students.

Cellphones at School From the first day of next term students will not be allowed cellphones with them at school. Caregivers are able to apply for an exemption for their child to leave their phone in the office during the day if they need it after school. If you would like a copy of the policy or a request form for a student to leave their phone at the office these are available at school.

NCEA University Entrance Over the past few editions of Genesis I have talked about NCEA qualifications and also how students can attain an endorsement. This week I want to explain how students attain University Entrance. While not all students see University or Polytechnic as a pathway for them, while they are in Year 13 we do encourage as many students as possible to attain University Entrance so that the option of completing a degree qualification is not closed to them.

To attain University Entrance a student must attain NCEA Level 3 and in addition they must have attained 14 credits in three approved subjects. A list of approved subjects can be found on the NZQA website. This list also identifies the specific standards that count towards the 14 credits.

Some University and Polytechnic courses also have specific entrance requirements. Therefore students need to check whether the course they are wanting to do has specific requirements and that the courses they are doing at school will provide an opportunity to meet them. If they are concerned that they may not be able to meet the specific entry requirements for the course they want to do then they must speak to us as soon as possible.

House Points Update We have had a strong start to the house competition this year and every student has contributed to their house point total. The events that have been held in Term One with the winning house are:

- ◆ Inter house touch - Reid
- ◆ Inter house quiz - Malcolm

When all the points have been collated Malcolm is in 4th place with 750 points, Ross in 3rd place with 810 points, Reid in 2nd place with 950 points and taking an early lead in the competition is Ayson with 1020 points. I can't wait to see if Ayson can maintain their lead next term or whether one of the other houses will snatch it away from them. One thing for sure is the competition for the house shield will be fierce.

Easter Egg Hunt After some rain delays our Prefect Team eventually managed to hold the Easter Egg Hunt last Friday on the school field. It was great to see so many of our students participating and having fun and of course eating the odd piece of chocolate.

Uniform With the clocks going back last weekend it is a reminder that winter is just around the corner. There are plenty of warm uniform options available for the colder days. In addition to the warm and waterproof jacket that is available at NZ Uniforms students are able to wear thermals under their uniform. However, hoodies are not part of our school uniform and are therefore not permitted at school. As always if there is a specific short term reason for incorrect uniform a student can obtain a uniform pass by providing a note from home.
