




Year 9 and 10 Music - Passion Project



SCHOOL MISSION: Inspiring Excellence in Education, in Character and in Life.

Kia ora,

Unfortunately, last week we were forced to make a decision to roster home our senior students on Thursday to conduct private study. The reason for this was that the teaching union the Post Primary Teachers Association (PPTA) have instructed their members to carry out a relief ban. This is to highlight to the Government and Ministry the extra work teachers do above and beyond their contractual agreements. Therefore, no members of staff in the union are able to relieve for their colleagues should they be away on professional development or sick. The solution to this is to employ relievers to cover these lessons. On Thursday unfortunately we were unable to acquire any relievers to cover classes, as I am sure you can imagine all schools in our area are also trying to staff their schools also. We therefore had to make the decision to ask seniors to stay home.

In terms of loss of learning this was unfortunate, but we must be aware that we were one of the few schools in the country who did not roster our student's home during Covid 19 last

year which was as a result of teachers willing to go above and beyond to ensure students needs were met in very trying and difficult circumstances. Teachers were considered by the Government and Ministry to be essential workers during this time.

Further action is also being considered with a 1-day strike arranged for Thursday 16th March. Should this proceed, we will only be open for Years 7 and 8. There are five members of staff who will not be striking this day as they are members of different unions, and they will be available to supervise students.

Rest assured that we will endeavor to remain open for all students throughout this period and ensure they get the best possible education and chances to succeed.

Obituary - John McKenzie

John McKenzie (or Johnny Mac as he was known by many) passed peacefully at Dunedin hospital after a short illness on Saturday 4th March 2023 at the age of 86.

John taught at Tokomairiro for nearly a quarter of a century and many families would have experienced his talents within their generations. John started out in the then new Form 1 - 7 high school in the late 1960's as the Physical Education teacher. Having graduated from Carnegie University in UK he brought with him a wealth of knowledge in many sports. His passion for coaching and young people never waned over his lifetime. He was one of the instigators of the present school gymnasium

After an overseas teaching assignment in Tonga in the mid 80's he returned to Toko as Head of English, and this was to be the start of his passion for reading recovery and adult literacy.

Not to rest on his laurels he embarked on Guidance Counsellor training and obtained his degree from Massey University in 1993. He then undertook the role of Guidance Counsellor at Toko for some seven years. During this time he showed his empathetic qualities and he cared and treated all those that crossed his door with respect and value.

John retired from teaching in 2001 and was still residing in Milton at the time of his death. In his later years he undertook qualifications in SPELD and Adult literacy and with his infinite patience he helped many obtain their dreams of reading and writing competencies.

John was always one to get involved and volunteered where he was needed. He undertook meals on wheels and hospital taxi driving and was a keen advocate of the Hub.

John loved to play and watch sport and it is only in later years that he had to give up his beloved Golf and Squash. John will be missed from the community by his many friends and acquaintances. John is survived by his brother Malcolm (UK) and his daughter Jennifer (Cambridge).

Water advisory issued for some rural water schemes

An advisory has been issued for people on the North Bruce, South Richardson and Moa Flat water schemes (including Waihola, Heriot and Kaka Point), after samples of drinking water in recent weeks found aluminium levels exceeding the new drinking water standard of 1mg/L.

A single high-level sample was found in Kaitangata, subsequent testing has not exceeded water standards. At Waitahuna there was one exceedance recently when the filter was bypassed for a few days. Once the filter was restored, aluminium levels returned to accepted levels.

Clutha District Council engaged the national water regulator Taumata Arowai, and Te Whatu Ora Health New Zealand to ensure the right technical, public health, and toxicology advice was received.

The health advice is that the risk of consuming water from the affected supplies is negligible; no health effects would be expected at these levels of aluminium exposure, even if water was consumed over a period of weeks to months. This includes effects for people with kidney disease, infants, and children.

Clutha District Mayor Bryan Cadogan says, "I know some people will be feeling anxious about this and that's understandable - I apologise for any concern this may cause. We've been told that with the acute levels of aluminium exposure for the period of

time we're talking about, there is negligible risk to people's health. Residents in these areas can keep drinking their water if they want to. For those who choose not to use their tap water, there will be water tankers at Waihola, Heriot and Kaka Point."

"Council staff have been engaging with Te Whatu Ora and Taumata Arowai to ensure we have expert advice and take the right actions to address this issue as quickly as possible."

The first lab samples showing exceedances were received by council in February 2023 and water regulator, Taumata Arowai was informed at this time.

While the cause is yet to be determined, work is underway to identify and resolve this issue, and testing is being undertaken daily.

Initial snapshot sampling at consumers' properties in the affected areas found aluminium levels were below water standard requirements and surveillance sampling is being increased to help get a better understanding.
