Making Milton a Cycling Hotspot!

Early this year, Project Bruce was approached by some pro-active students from Tokomairiro High School who are keen to expand cycling opportunities for the people of the district and visitors. They floated the idea of a pump track (a circuit designed with banked turns, rollers and jumps) and/or a mountain bike park for Milton. We thought this was a brilliant idea and would fit perfectly with the success of the beautiful Clutha Gold Trail. Why not make Milton a cycling Mecca?!

We are currently looking at possible sites for both options and have some promising leads. The idea will be to provide inclusive facilities for cyclists of all skill levels to foster fitness, confidence and development of technique. With our help, the students have launched a survey and have had thoughts on options and designs. We have made connections with park designers and are looking at possible grant funding sources.

We know there is a lot happening in Milton at the moment in terms of development, so want to make this process as user-friendly as possible. This project is in its infancy, but once we have a solid plan there will be an opportunity for enthusiastic community members to jump in with knowledge, resources and elbow-grease! In the meantime, pop your two cents into the survey (scan the QR code) so that we can gather some data and thoughts. Have a fantastic Christmas – watch this space in 2024!

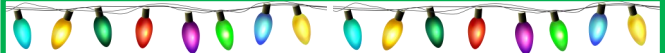

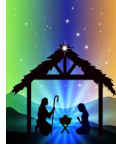
