How can we help you?

– an update from Clutha Budget Advisory Service

As the year is quickly coming to an end we wanted to share with the Milton community some of the highlights for our organisation.

The number of people who have received Financial Mentoring in Milton (including Waihola and Lawrence) has increased 67% this year. In Balclutha (and the wider area), the numbers increased 73% on the previous year. We have managed these increases with the same staffing and support from our hands-on Governance and Management Board. At the same time we are working on increasing the support we offer and will be in a position to make announcements about this in early 2022.

In August we were excited to be announced as joint winners of the Health and Wellbeing Section of the Clutha District Council Community Awards, for our Happy Feet Project. Happy Feet is a fund we have set up with support from the Clutha Foundation and Balclutha Rotary, to buy school shoes for young people in South Otago. We receive referrals to this from schools, community organisations and directly from families who are working with our service. To date we have sent 54 young people off to school with new school shoes this year – an incredible achievement.

We are acutely aware that the start of each school year puts extra pressure on families, and we want to make sure that everyone knows what financial assistance is available in the community. Aside from Happy Feet, we are able to process applications for the J R McKenzie Youth Education Fund – to help towards the purchase of a school uniform for students who are entering their first year of either high school or intermediate. If you, or someone you know, would like to enquire about either of these funds, please contact us confidentially for a chat about how to apply.

Some of the other ways we can assist clients is talking to creditors (the people you owe money to) about hardship provisions, if your situation has changed and you are unable to keep up with your agreed payments. We work through Kiwisaver Hardship withdrawal applications, and can talk about and can assist with insolvency options. We are also able to look at options for community finance for people who have a low income, and/or poor credit, but have an essential need. Examples include include BYO devices for study, course costs and fees, second-hand cars, car repairs, new household appliances and some debt consolidation.

Our Financial Mentor works in the Tokomairiro Hub every Monday, and in Balclutha Tuesday – Friday. If you would like an appointment please contact us on 03 418 0463, 027 781 1041 or budgetingclutha@gmail.com

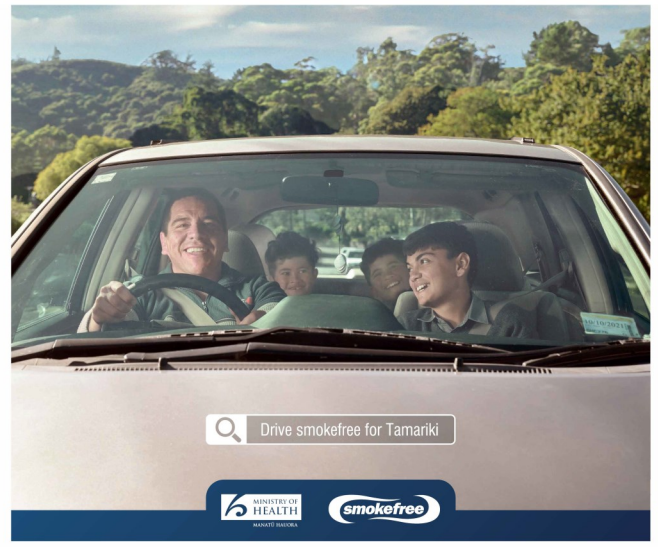

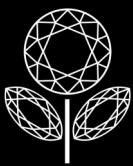
