Thirty Years of Service

Clutha Budget Advisory Service has been providing budget advice / financial mentoring in the Clutha District, including Milton, since 1993. That's right - it is 30 years since we became an official Charitable Trust.

There have been many changes in the world of personal finances over the years, but as an organisation we have been very fortunate to have had relatively few staffing changes. We have only had two, both very dedicated, Coordinators. For the first 16 years Liz Taylor was the Coordinator as well as a Budget Advisor. Liz led and trained a team of volunteer Budget Advisers and remained on the Board and as a Trustee until she moved to Christchurch in 2018

Lee-Anne Michelle joined the organisation as a volunteer in 2005, was trained and mentored by Liz, and took over as Coordinator in 2009. For the past 14 years Lee-Anne has worked as a Budget Adviser / Financial Mentor and completed training and professional development in a range of areas. As the role of budget advising became more specialised volunteer budget advisers were replaced by professionally trained Financial Mentors, and Lee-Anne was joined in 2021 by Amy Senada who now also provides Financial Mentoring based in Balclutha and has a special interest in supporting older people with banking and technology solutions in this digital age.

Lee-Anne has recently taken on another role as Practice Manager of Milton Medical Centre three days a week, while continuing with her Clutha Budget Advisory Service role the other two days.

Amy is available on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday. As well as face-to-face appointments some people now like to work with a Financial Mentor solely via email, and this is an option we are happy to accommodate, along with online meetings.
