As the school holidays are drawing to a close we are well underway with making plans and setting our priorities for 2024. Some of our priorities will be centred around the changes to NCEA and also developing our understanding of the curriculum changes that are in the pipeline. Other priorities will be fostering and deepening links with our local community and building a stronger sense of community within the school. We are very grateful for all support we receive from our community in helping us develop our students to reach their potential and look forward to working with our Milton community again this year.

#### Start of Year Information

We are very excited to welcome all of our new students to school as well as welcoming back our existing students next week.

This year we will be starting school on Monday 29th January. This day will be for Year 7 and Year 13 students only. The day will start with a mihi whakatau to welcome our new dents into our school. We ask that all students gather outside at 8.40am, parents and caregivers are welcome to stay for the mihi whakatau. Once the mihi whakatau is completed the students will go off to their classrooms, meet their teachers and work with our Year 13 students. At 2.30pm we welcome all the caregivers to join us for a BBQ where you will have an opportunity to meet the staff. Year 7 students do not need to bring all their books with them but should bring a pen or

Pencil. Tuesday 30th January the whole school will attend. Students should arrive by 8.40 and go straight to the hall for a

whole school assembly.

#### **Course Confirmation**

After the exam results some students may want to review their course selection for this year. Staff will be available for course confirmation on Wednesday 24th January from 8.30 am until 3pm. No appointments are required but students may need to be prepared to wait if they arrive at a busy time. Caregivers are more than welcome to also attend course confirmation. Please note that Thursday 25th and Friday 26th are Teacher Only days and staff will be unavailable for course confirmation on these days.

#### Staffing Update

The School Board is currently working through the Principal appointment process. This process is not quick and therefore we will be starting the school year with myself as Acting Principal. Bill McClure will be Acting Deputy Principal and Kris Simpson will be stepping into the Senior Leadership Team as Acting Assistant Principal.

### **NCEĂ** Results

NCEA results are looking very good so far but the final statistics will not be available until early March. Early indications show that the overall pass rate of NCEA has increased at all three levels. At most levels we have bucked the national trend of downward achievement and have managed to improve our overall results on past years. also have a larger number of students who have gained both overall endorsements as well as course endorsements. Currently almost 10% of our students gained an overall endorsement for NCEA and almost 15% of students attained a course endorsement at Merit or Excellence in at least one subject.



# **Cricket Report**

The Waihola Swans successfully defended the Challenge Cup for the second consecutive week with an eight-wicket victory over the Clutha Comets at Crab Grounds in Milton. Opting to bat first, Clutha's opening pair built a solid foundation and Jared Hayes later contributed with three wickets for 16 runs. Clutha was bowled out for 107 in the 25th over.

The Waihola Swans' top order efficiently chased down the target losing only two wickets. Dylan Bungard, Lachie MacDonald, Rowan Craw, and Shannon Young played crucial roles. Waihola's successful defence sets the stage for a monumental clash with the Owaka Bandits next weekend, where three trophies will be up for grabs.

The Owaka Bandits secured a 36-run victory against the Milton King Crabs at the Outlaw Oval in Owaka. Opting to bat first, the Bandits faced early challenges but Daniel Simmonds and Francis Parker contributed vital runs, helping the Bandits reach 164 all out. Corey Bradley's four wickets for 18 runs were the highlight for Milton. In response, Owaka initially struggled with inconsistent bowling, but emerged victorious.

The Bandits now sit in outright third on the table and prepare for a blockbuster clash against Waihola with three trophies at stake, while Milton looks to carry their positive performance into the upcoming match against the Kai Kings.

The Clutha District Council plans to increase the size of the camping ground here. We're told that for a camping ground to be viable, it needs approximately 20 cabins, 50 caravan power outlets, areas for tents and ablution blocks. There is not enough room on Taylor Park for both a viable camping ground and park.

With no definite date for the removal of the present swimming pool, this construction could linger for years.


