

### How are you getting on without cheques?



Earlier this year there was quite an uproar from many people in our community when we found out that cheques would be discontinued. This of course, followed on from the closure of all of Milton's banks, with a similar trajectory following in Balclutha with only two part-time banks remaining. The Clutha Budget Advisory Service were selected as the only South Island budgeting service, to

We were selected due to the large geographical area of the Clutha District, the number of banks that had closed, and the distance people have to travel to a main centre (Dunedin) for banks that have closed their branches in Balclutha.

Amy is available to help you to work out a plan on how to manage your personal banking without cheques. It may be that you need help to learn to use online banking or a banking app, or to set up payments. Senior Prizegiving

Vaccinations for Education came into effect at 11.59pm on Berwick Camp from 23rd 25th November These are great Monday 25 October. From 1 January 2022, schools, early learning services and providers will need to maintain a register, and ensure only vaccinated staff and support people have contact with children and students. They need to have their first dose by 15 November. Secondary schools and kura will also be required to keep a COVID-19 vaccination register for students. Students who do not produce evidence of vaccination will be considered unvaccinated. We are currently working on a format to collect that information from all our students and adults.

#### **School Buses**

All students aged 12 and over are required to wear masks on school buses. We encourage all our students to follow this Ministry of Health guideline and ask for parental support.

#### Social Sciences: 10Ha Social Studies

In our class this term we are focusing on important issues and New Zealand knowledge. We began this study by looking at how teenagers today differ from those of our grandparents. We looked at a documentary explaining about hyper-parenting (characterized by excessive attention to children) and what this is doing to today's teenagers.

We followed the viewing with a brief discussion and then we had to write a paragraph about what sort of parent we would like to be in the future and why.

For example, 'Anonymous' wrote:

"I want to be a good mother and how I would be a good mother is by loving my child and protecting him or her but I will not be a hyper-parent.

I want my child to be an independent person because one day I will die and he or she must learn to cope in the real world. Personally, I think that being a hyper-parent is not good for the child because that child will get used to getting help and will possibly get stressed. I want my child to follow his or her dreams but still be able to survive in the world".

### My Outward Bound Experience

Nic Clark spent three weeks at Anikiwa in October. He shares his experience:

Outward Bound is a once in a lifetime course that not many people get to experience. I can not thank the Bruce Stewart Foundation enough for giving me this opportunity.

My overall experience was very enjoyable because of the range of activities there were to do. There wasn't a moment where I didn't have something I could be doing.

The day would start by waking up at 5:50am to get ready for the morning PT at 6:20am. We would run 3.2km and jump into the freezing cold ocean - not a wake up I am used to. We were never told what the day had in store for us and each time we tried to ask questions, they gave the same response: 'ma te wa' (time will tell).

The activities I found the most memorable were sailing in gale-force winds, looking over the Nelson area at over 1200m and whitewater kayaking. These are things I would have never got to experience if I didn't take this opportunity. I thoroughly recommend to others who not only want a physical challenge, but also a mental one to go on Outward Bound. It will push you out of your comfort zone multiple times.
