SCHOOL MISSION: Inspiring Excellence in Education, in Character and in Life.

Kia ora.

As mentioned last week our school mission is "To work together to inspire excellence in education, in character and in life" One aspect of our character is resilience which by definition is the ability to recover quickly from difficulties and this is certainly a year like no other and has been full of difficulties for us as individuals and as a school. However, things in life have always been difficult and it is by persevering that we develop our strength and character. The author Travis Bradberry states that:

"Humans are creatures of habit. If you quit when things get tough, it gets that much easier to quit the next time. On the other hand, if you force yourself to push through it, the grit begins to grow in you."

So, when teachers are working with students it is imperative that students are working outside their comfort zone in order to challenge them to achieve but not too far outside that the task or piece of work is viewed as unattainable. There is often a delicate balance between what the student believes they are capable of and what the teacher knows they can do.

However, failure has a part to play in developing our resilience. Its only by getting things wrong that we can improve and get better next time. No sportsman ever got it right first time and will have practiced over and over to eliminate the minor flaws in their technique to arrive at the final finished product.

Encouraging this ability to give it another go or trying harder in our classes is frustrating for the student and teacher, but the reward is so great that it is worth the effort. Two of the most important words in the English language are NEXT TIME. You have an opportunity to try again and get it right or get better until you get it right. So we are encouraging our students to get into those positive "Can Do" attitudes where they develop the grit needed to improve and achieve "Excellence in Character"

These qualities are particularly important for our seniors as we approach the half way stage of the year.




