Medal Recipient is a One - in - 2.4 Billon Hero!

In August 2022, the Kandegoda Gamage family were visiting Chrystall's Beach near Milton, when a rogue wave swept Kithmi sixty metres out to sea within seconds. The brothers were playing at the edge of the water which was described as 'big seas with a 3 metre surf', when Kithmni lost his footing. He trod water for a few moments, putting into practice the water skills he had been taught in Sri Lanka, but the strength of the water was too much for him to make any traction.

Kalya, his older brother ,realised he couldn't get back to shore. He told his mother 'Ok mum, I'm going out. I might not be back', and he entered the huge seas to save him, utilising the lifesaving skills he had also been taught.

Yesterday, the whole school, along with Marie Baker (President) and Judi Jessop (Secretary) from the Royal New Zealand Life Saving Society of New Zealand celebrated Kalya's act of heroism. Also present were members of Fire and Emergency New Zealand, New Zealand Police and St John Ambulance who attended on the day, and local dignitaries.

Kalya was presented with the prestigious Mountbatten Medal for 2022. There is only **one** award presented within the Comonwealth (a population of over 2.4

billion) each year, and Kalya is also the youngest ever to receive this award. His name will be added to the roll of Honour at the headquarters in England, which has four other New Zealanders and two Sri Lankans on it since it's inception in 1951.

After receiving his medal and a framed citation, Kalya thanked those who had played a part in his story. He made special mention of those who taught him swimming and lifesaving skills in Sri Lanka, his parents and siblings, emergency services and those who provided assistance at the beach on the day.

Tokomairiro High School would like to acknowledge Kalya's acheivement—we are very proud of him!

today regarding one of our school students. It is my pleasure to inform you that Kalya Kandegoga Gamage has been awarded the prestigious Mountbatten Medal. This is in recognition of his heroic rescue of his younger brother Kithmmi from Chrystall's Beach last year

The Mountbatten Medal is awarded annually for the most gallant rescue or rescue attempt undertaken in the previous year. It is awarded to only to one person in the whole commonwealth. This is therefore a significant award for Kalya who is by far the youngest person to receive this award.

As a school, we take great pride in nurturing and supporting the growth of our students. Helping them to realise their potential and live up to our school values of Respect, Responsibility and Excellence. Kalya and the vast majority of our students live up to these on a daily basis and are a credit to themselves and their families.

A special assembly was held on Monday 24th to make the award to Kalya with almost 40 invited guests, including many of the rescue services that were involved on the day, to share in this occasion.
