Late last week we had our house group elections. These students are our new House Captains for 2021.





Skool Loop App




House Captains 2021

A Legacy to Inspire Excellence.

Today, 16th February, marks the launch of the Bruce Stewart Leadership Programme. On what would have been Mr. Bruce Stewart's 90th birthday, the Stewart family announced a local programme to promote leadership and development. Bruce Stewart ONZM, the co-founder of nationwide property and construction company Calder Stewart, was an avid supporter of the Tokomairiro region during his life. Since his passing in 2018, and on his wishes, his family estate has worked to develop a programme to support people from the local area and inspire excellence.

The programme is an annual monetary fund of up to \$50,000 for the benefit of the people of the Tokomairiro region. The programme aims to promote leadership development and is open to current and former residents who seek to further their leadership credentials.

Bruce Stewart's granddaughter Lauren Thornhill will manage the programme and hopes the programme will honour her grandfather's legacy and support the next generation of Tokomairiro leaders. There are two funding rounds each year and applications are now open via the website www.brucestewartleadership.org.

Since September 2019 the wonderful kitchen at Otago Corrections Facility has created a delicious, nutritious and imaginative selection of goodies for our local kids with ingredients supplied by food rescue organisation, KiwiHarvest. We would like to extend a HUGE thank you to all the agencies involved in this project, which have supplied up to 80 lunches each day. We will continue to work with OCF and also KiwiHarvest who have been supplying food for the Hub's Free Market. In the last week of work before the holiday break, they enabled us to give away fifteen Christmas hampers supplied by Anchor and approximately twenty five mixed groceries parcels, which was a great way to end the year. All up, we have redistributed approximately 10 tonnes of surplus or near-date food in the last year. So good!!
