## **Tokomairiro High School Newsletter...**

SCHOOL MISSION: Inspiring Excellence in Education, in Character and in Life.

#### How did we do in our NCEA exams?

The final confirmed results from last year have been published and schools around the country will be crunching the numbers to see how successful their students have been, and we are no different.

At first glance we can see that our results have dropped from last year and would appear to be very disappointing. Our Level 1 students dropped their success rate from 87.9% pass rate in 2020 to 68.6 in 2021. A significant drop. Our Level 2 students went from 84% in 2020 to 79.3 % in 2021 - a much smaller drop but still disappointing. However, when we make comparisons between our school with other schools nationally and also with similar schools (Decile 4) we can see that we have held our own particularly at Level 1 and Level 2.

We are looking at how we might support our current students throughout the rest of this year in order to ensure we can make the most of the time we have left. This will give them best opportunity to succeed. On the whole we should be pleased that students are coping with the constant interruptions to their learning and being resilient enough to keep on going and persevere.

On another positive note many of our students received their HPV vaccine this week. The staff running the vaccination felt the need to report that our students during the process were the best behaved amongst all the schools that they had worked in. Its good hear and see our students living up to the school mission of "Inspiring excellence in education, character and life."




