Keith and his elder late brother John, each built identical yachts side by side in John's shed in Tokoiti.

(John's yacht 'Omeo', was launched quite a few years ago).
The workmanship of the *Emma Jean* (named after his mum Emma, and Keith's late wife Allayne's mum Jean) is testimony to the careful eye Keith has in giving attention to detail, and his skill not only in building the beautiful macrocarpa wood interior but in the many created components, and the superb overall finish of the vessel itself. This has truly been a labour of love and sacrifice over many years.

Keith now 82 years old, has greatly appreciated all the support of his family in helping to bring the launch day to fruition. Launching a yacht of this size is no mean feat and it required meticulous preparation and planning just to remove the yacht from John's shed.

Keith thanks his sons Neil and Paul Rutherford and families for their hours of preparation work. The towing company R&R Hiab were fantastic at lifting the yacht onto the trailer and driving it to the Otago Harbour; and the crane team at the yacht club ensured a successful launch watched on by neighbours, friends and family who were gathered.

Boat building has been a passion of Keith's right from when he was a boy at high school building his first row boat on the same property, his old family home in Tokoiti.

Keith's family are immensely proud of all of their fathers achievements and look forward to many years of sailing with their Dad.
