Milton Emergency Services Motor Vehicle Accident Training

On the evening of Wednesday 21st September, the Milton Volunteer FENZ Brigade and Milton Volunteer St John held a combined motor vehicle accident training exercise at the corner of Elderlee and Edward Streets. The exercise was used as an opportunity for FENZ members to practice in a 'real-life' setting scene size-up, patient extrication skills and scene management. Milton St John members also drew on their skills of scene assessment and triage, patient care and communications.

Both agencies were turned out from their respective stations in a staggered fashion just after 7pm, arriving on scene to find not only a van on it's side with people trapped but also a building crowd of around 40 onlookers. FENZ crew assessed the scene for hazards and patient access options whilst St John crew assessed and triaged patients in order of priority. Further resources were requested through respective 'Communication Centres'. Both teams communicated well together for the most efficient patient pathways and provided a high standard of care – the ultimate goal of the exercise. The evening was a great success with many new learnings for all involved. The Milton FENZ Brigade and Milton St John would like to thank the 'patient' volunteers for their time and acting skills, The St John Casualty Simulation Team for providing 'injuries', Kiwi Auto Parts & Mechanical for the van and the Mill owners for their footpath.
