We already collect our food scraps for the chickens and the children have enjoyed discussing and comparing the different foods in our scrap containers with the list of foods the worms can eat. We discovered that worms like to eat bananas and apples but not sandwiches and oranges and that they like to live in places that are dark and warm.

organised mayhem at the Milton Bruce RSA. I've heard on my wireless that the Rugby Pics start on 18th


