Project Bruce – Where to From Here?



Project Bruce is now in its fifth year as the community-led development organisation for Milton, Waihola and Taieri Mouth.

In 2017 we conducted a community consultation, asking what people loved about the area, what they would like to change and how we could help facilitate these wishes. The feedback from this resulted in our community plan and a number of projects which we have been working on over the last few years. We also continue to help action ideas which are presented to us and always endeavour to harness the energy and desires of the community as they arise.

Our projects (both complete and ongoing) include the establishment of the Bruce Community Shed, the community garden, Feeding our Kids school lunch programme, free day, DIY instructional videos, a community cookbook, updates during Covid, sustainability and educational workshops, Taieri Mouth trapping project support, coffee groups and much more.

We are now gearing up to check-in with the Bruce Community once more to find out what the hopes and dreams for the area are in 2021 and beyond. So, now is the time to start having conversations with those around you about what you would love to see occurring in the district over the next few years. We will provide ways for you to communicate your thoughts over the coming months - from surveys to individual chats to larger gatherings!! Fun times ahead!!



Toi Ataata - Visual Art

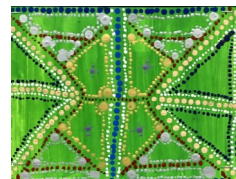
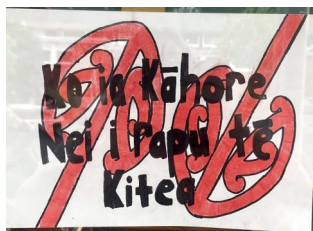
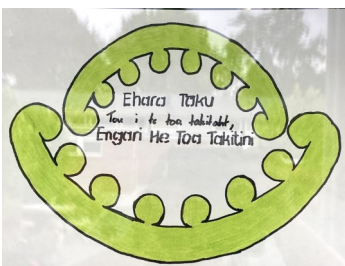
In Toi ataata the students have been investigating a range of artists, techniques and materials to create interesting works of art.

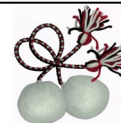
