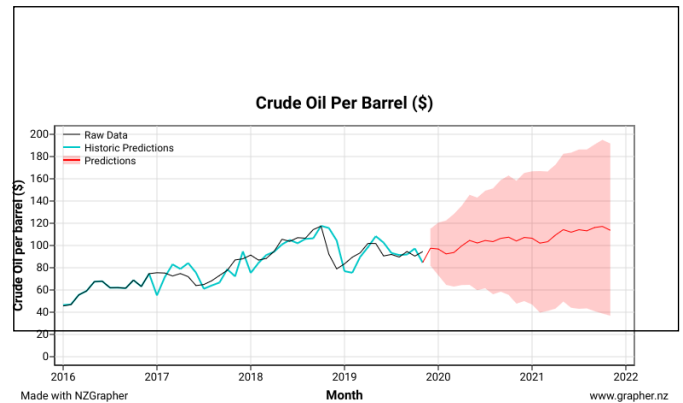

Senior Statistics – When are we ever gunna use this?!

Mathematics & Statistics have developed as very separate subjects and the latter is, increasingly, the mainstream subject for students not pursuing a technical career. Our Year 13 students have just completed a major topic called Time Series where they learn the modelling techniques similar to what we hear about in the media relating to the COVID pandemic.

In their formal assessment our students looked at making a model predicting Crude Oil Prices based on trends from previous years and they developed an understanding of the accuracy, potential volatility, robustness and limitation of predictions.

Although students learned the calculations behind making predictions, the power of computers removes much of the tedium of calculation and allows students to focus on understanding and interpretation of the data that they process.

The assessment data used was from 2008- 2020 but showed noticeable disruptions at several points. Readers can see, above, the limitations of modelling (based on the most recent pattern this month's prediction was between \$40 & \$190 per barrel showing the issues when political decisions can affect both direction and usefulness of modelling).

"Learning this skill will help me next year during part of my study, with biostatistics at university. I also enjoyed being able to predict for the future in this standard and think it would be useful in the future." (Morganne-Lee Greene). Although their assessment was on such a volatile dataset, students also met situations where data modelling over time could be used as a valuable planning tool within an industry.

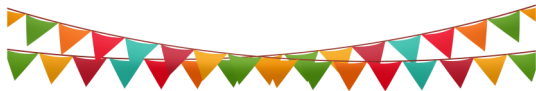

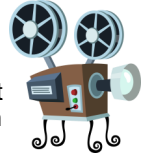
