Vietnam Veteran Addresses History Students

On Friday 4th March, Tokomairiro High School History students met via Zoom with Kevin Baff as part of their focus on New Zealand's

involvement in the Vietnam conflict.

Mr Baff was a member of the Royal Australian Air

Royal Australian Air Force and later the RNZAF based at HQ NZDF Wellington.

He served with the RNZAF (Wing Commander) and NZ Army TF (Lieutenant Colonel). He then worked with the International Committee of the Red Cross as an Armed and Security Forces Delegate / Coordinator in a number of armed conflict areas including Nepal, Afghanistan, Ethiopia and Gaza. His work in these areas was dealing with International Humanitarian Law / Law of Armed Conflict education for arms carriers and the investigation of alleged breaches.

Mr Baff shared his RAAF experiences during the Vietnam War with the class, as well as his insights as to what motivated him to pursue a career in the military, changes in the public's attitude toward the conflict over time, how students of history need to approach the topic, and how our involvement and experiences then can inform how we react to events happening in the world around us now. Mr Baff has pledged to continue to support the class, particularly as they embark on their research topics, and we simply cannot thank him enough!

It is quite difficult to write this statement without considering the unfortunate citizens of Ukraine and the plight they are undergoing, and then making comparisons with how our lives are so much different.

As a teacher I cannot resist the opportunity to give a guick history lesson.

When the Soviet Union collapsed in 1991, Ukraine became independent. Ukraine inherited much of the Soviet Union's nuclear arsenal but was unable to use them as Russia had all the launch codes etc in order to make them usable. The Ukrainians then surrendered this arsenal to Russia in 1994. This was part of the Budapest Memorandum where Russia guaranteed Ukraine's security and promised to respect its sovereignty.

The memorandum prohibited the Russian Federation, the United Kingdom and the United States from threatening or using military force or economic coercion against Ukraine, Belarus, and Kazakhstan.

Putin has breached this agreement to prevent Ukraine from Joining NATO and also to prevent NATO from expanding its influence.

With all that is going on with Covid, and the normal routines we have in our daily lives, we are still free to live our lives pretty much without any concerns. We can still attend school and work towards our qualifications without any real interruption to our daily lives

For many of us our health and wellbeing are not being challenged to any great degree. Our homes are still safe, and we have sufficient food and water to live comfortably. We are currently worried about the increased price of fuel but to put this in perspective it is worth noting that it is just now become more expensive than Coca Cola and still cheaper than beer. Take a moment to relish the freedoms we have and that we have choices and opportunities. As Nelson Mandela stated:

"Education is the most powerful weapon you can use to change the world.'




