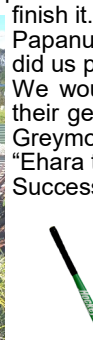

## South Island Secondary School Hockey Tournament Week Greymouth 2023

Toko Boys 1st XI Tāne Hockey team traveled to Greymouth to compete in the South Island Secondary School's tier 4 tournament. There were 16 teams in the competition, eight boys and eight girls from all over the South Island. Nate, our goalie, injured himself the Thursday before heading away, so we had to find someone to fill in. We were fortunate to source Phoenix Fowler from the Greymouth girl's team. We also had two players, Jack and Jordan, from Bayfield High School, who were also part of the team.

Our first game was against James Hargest, in which we drew one all. On Tuesday, we played an 8 o'clock game against Rangiora. We were up at 6.00 for breakfast and at the turf by 7.15. Unfortunately, we lost that game 3-0. So we returned to camp, regrouped, and reflected on what to do better for the next game. Later that day, we drove to Hokitika for lunch before heading to the treetop walkway adventure park. The views were spectacular from the top of the tower. We highly recommend this activity if you are over on the West Coast.

On Wednesday, we played at 1.20 pm, so we decided to play a round of mini golf to fill in the time. It's fair to say that some of the boys should stick to playing hockey. After a light lunch, we headed to the turf, ready to take on Papanui. It was the best game the boys had played all season. The passing and communication helped to win 3-1, which gave the boys confidence going into the next round. The next day, we played Kaiapoi, who sat at the bottom of Pool A. We were confident going into this game but didn't want to count our chickens before they hatched. We witnessed four extraordinary goals, which secured us a spot to play for 5th/6th place. ## Taylor Park Recreational Reserve

There is a growing concern from the locals about the Temporary One-Bedroom Cabins being moved onto Milton's Taylor Park. Questions in the community are mainly concerned with who the accommodation is for - Single workers? Trail Bike Riders? Released Prisoners or the homeless? We have had no clear communication from the Clutha district Council regarding this, and even they seem to have differing views on their use, as well as not being able to answer what else they have planned for the park, or how many other cabins might be moved there.

While the idea of prisoners learning valuable skills and producing quality builds is a real plus on both counts, our real concern is the use of land deemed Park and Recreational Reserve, and the speed and stealth at which this has proceeded. The main concern though, is the lack of consultation with the Milton and Tokomairiro community.

The council have extended the submission period to 28th September 2023 – there is no opportunity prior to this date to see the development first hand. This date is also being advertised as the 'drop in date', meaning there is no time afterwards for people to realistically submit their concerns.
